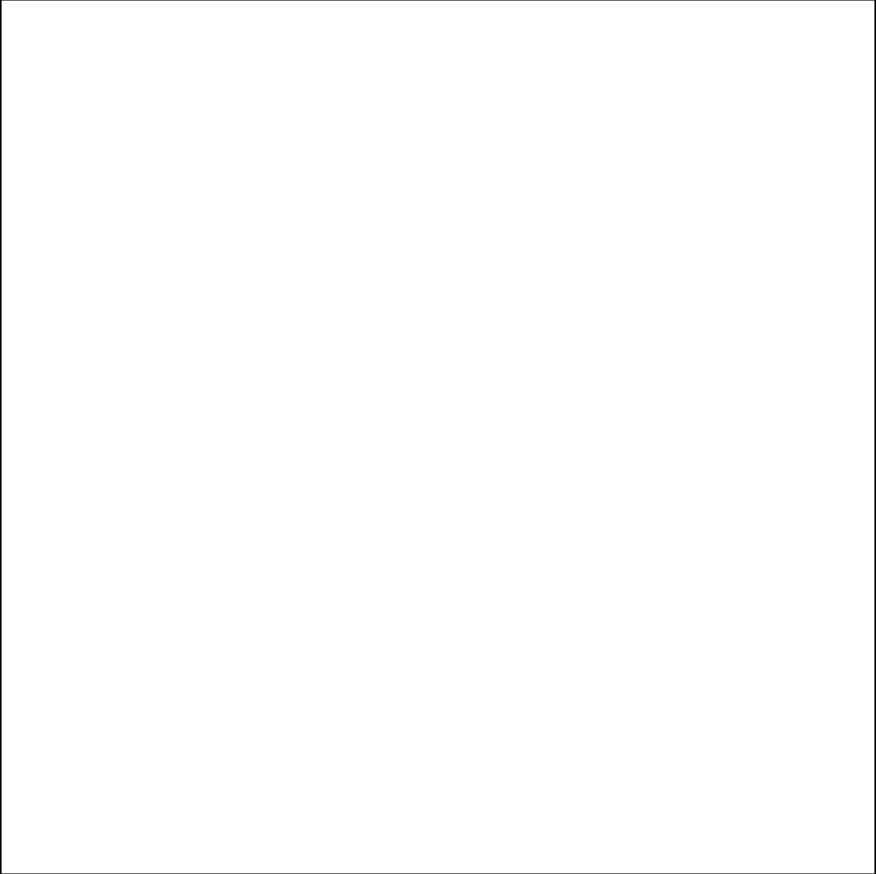









swimming in the water.




Isang leon ang umatungal.
