

Capra, Cane e Mucca erano grandi amici. Un giorno andarono in gita in un taxi.



pagò la sua parte.






Cane pagò un po' di più, perché non aveva i soldi esatti.

And Cow is not bothered when a car is coming. Cow takes her time crossing the road because she knows she paid her fare in full.


The driver was about to give Dog his change
