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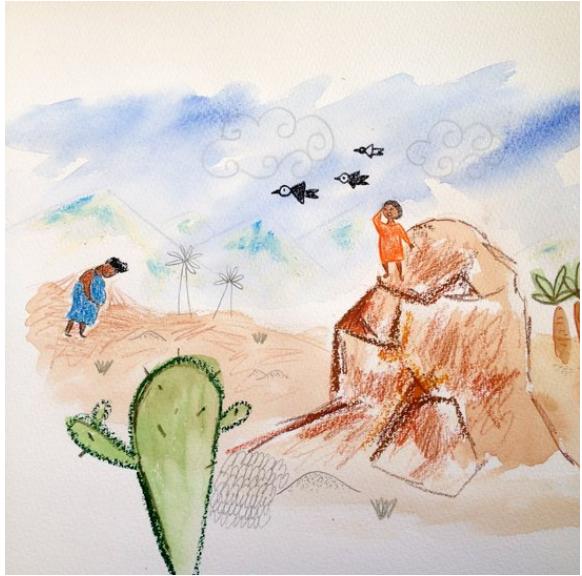
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有個女仔最先發現遠處有個好奇怪嘅影喺度。

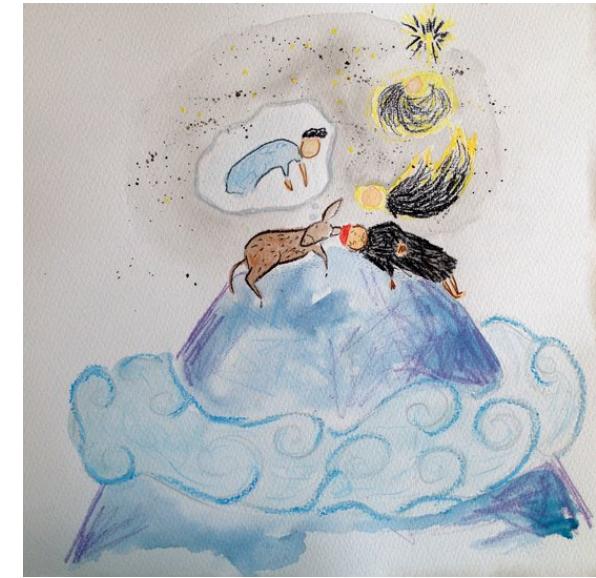


