






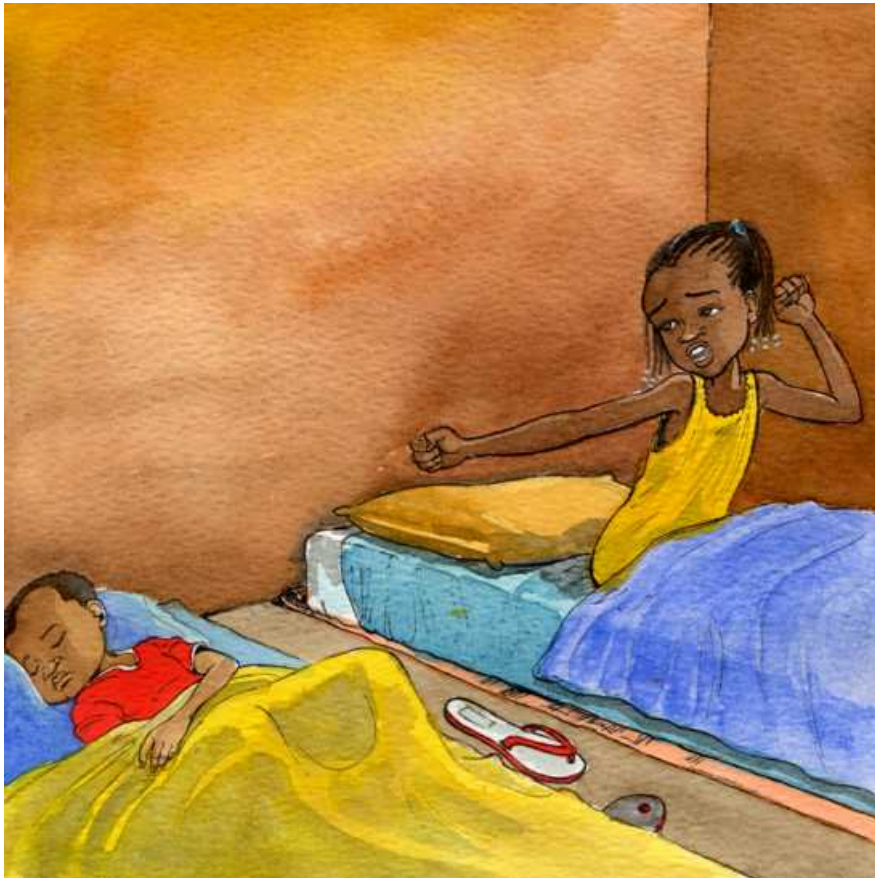


Magaling si Zama!

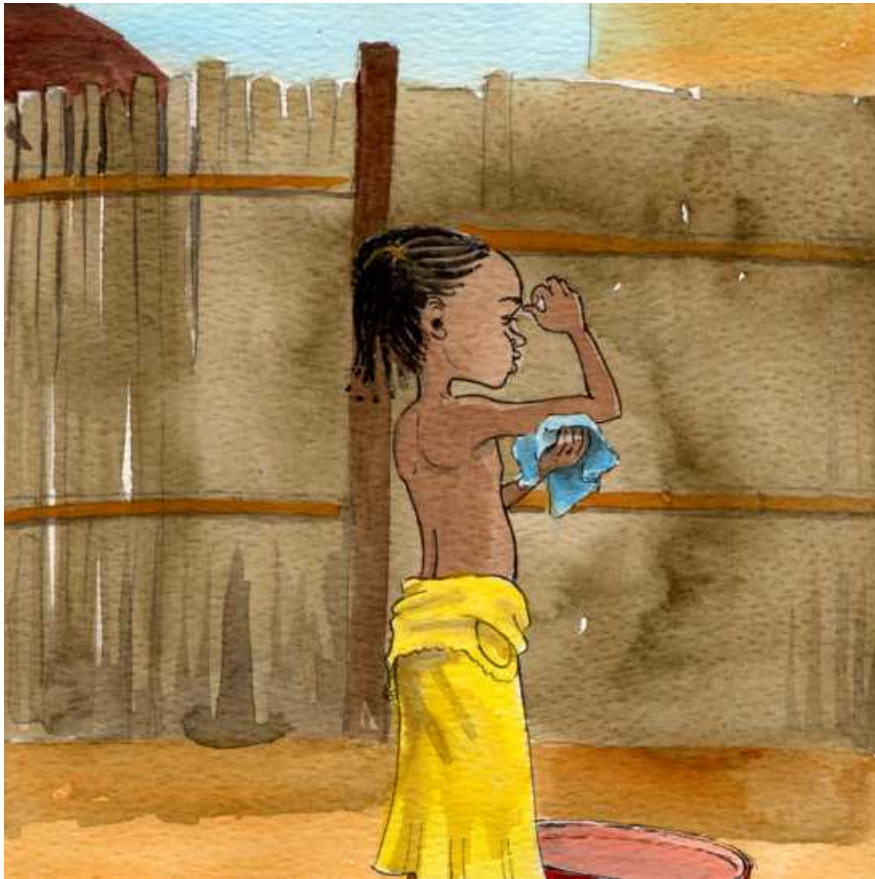
I am the one who lets in the sun.

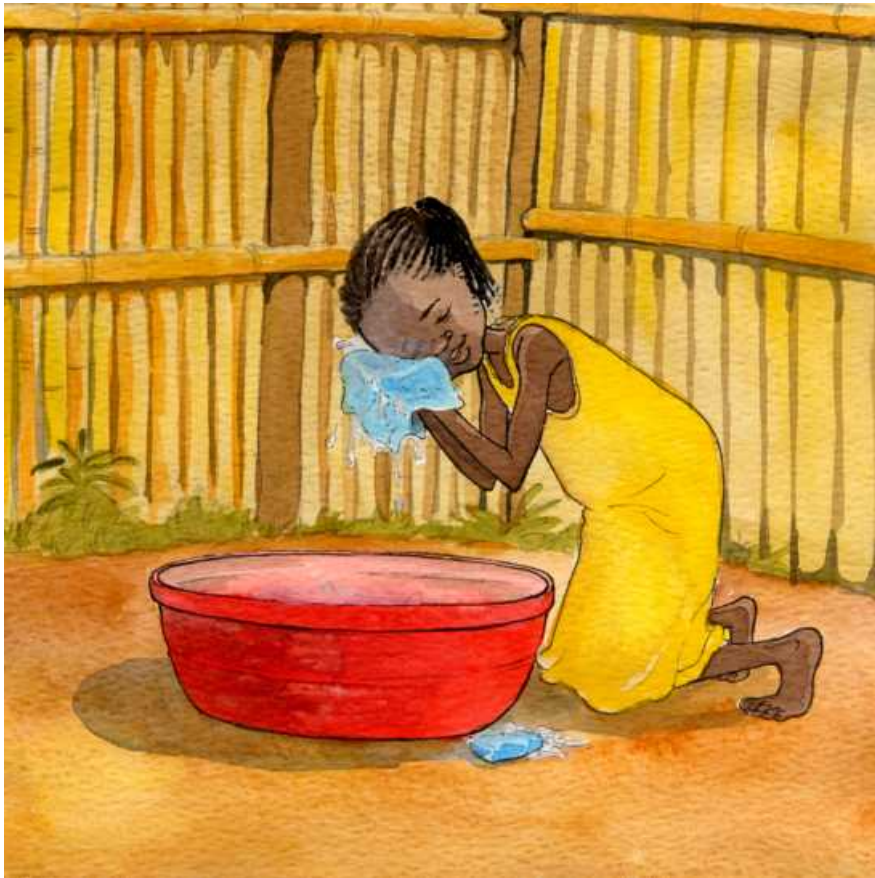
“You’re my morning star,” says

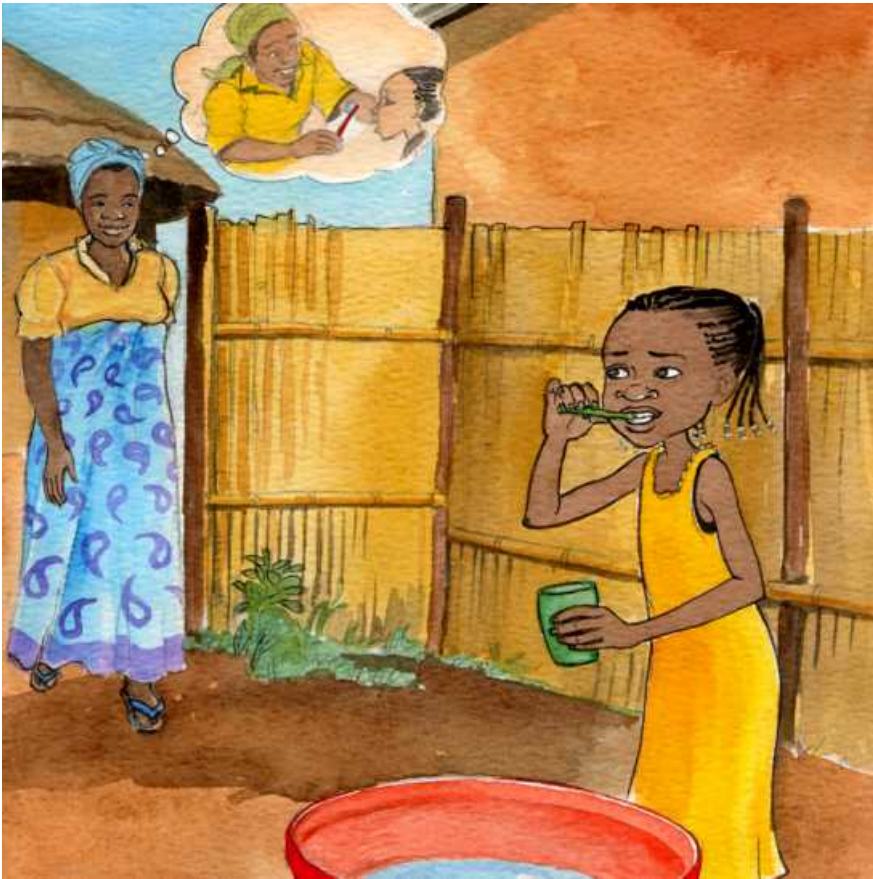
I wash myself, I don't need any

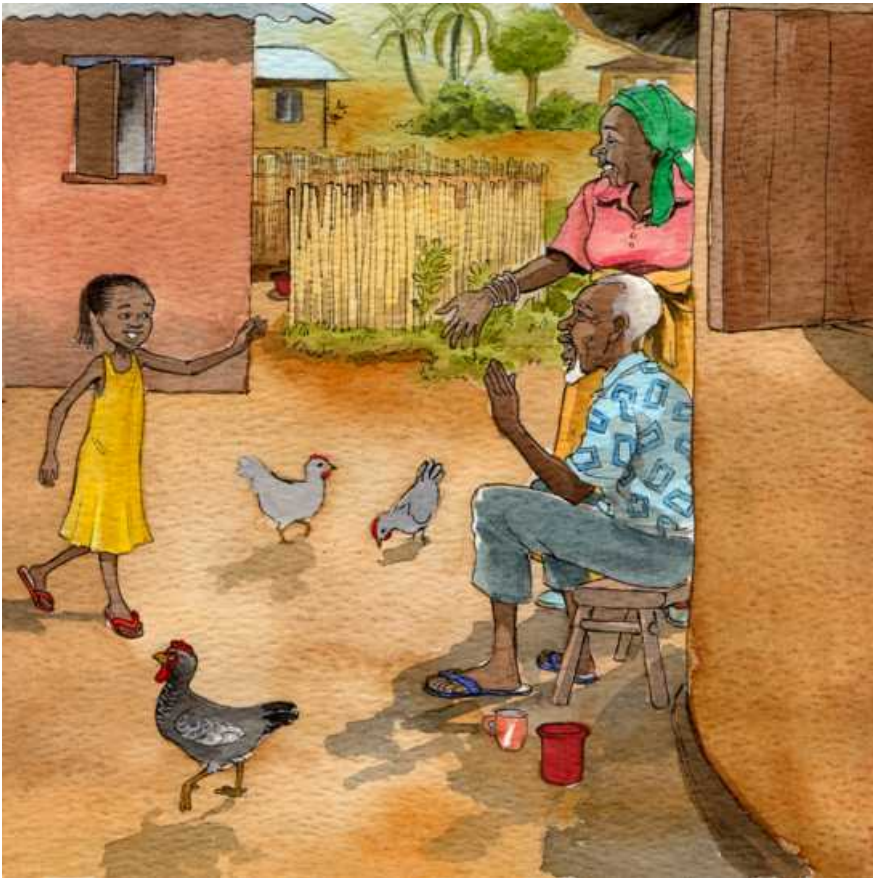
I can cope with cold water and blue smelly soap.

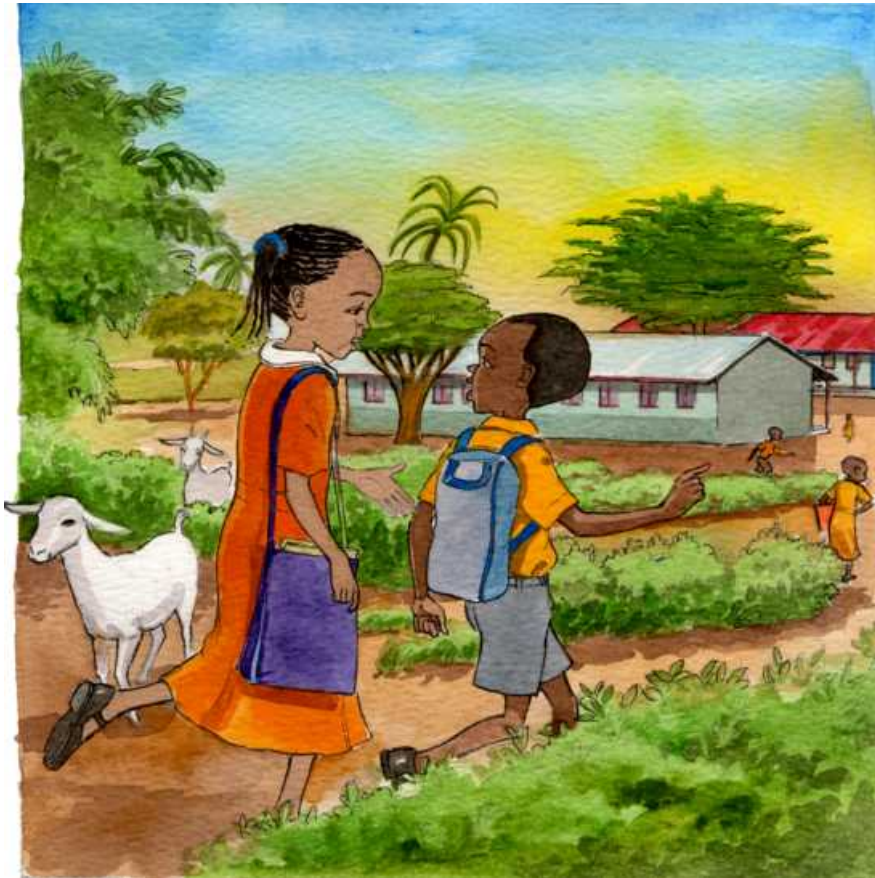
Then I dress myself, "I'm big now Ma," I say.

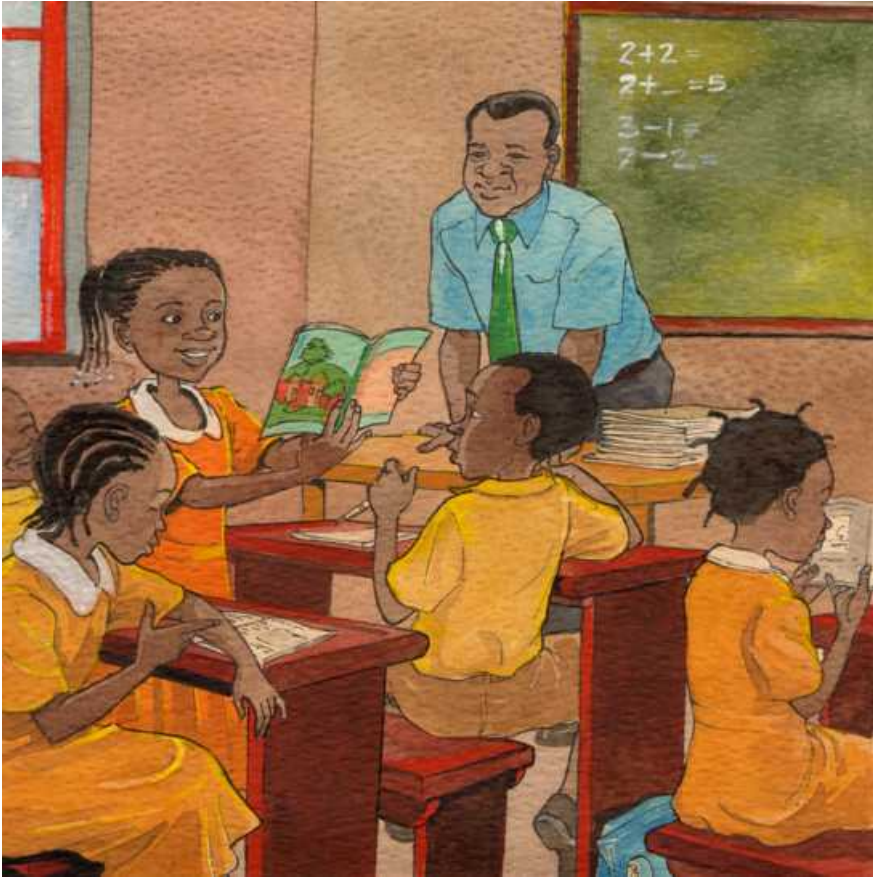
I can close my buttons and buckle

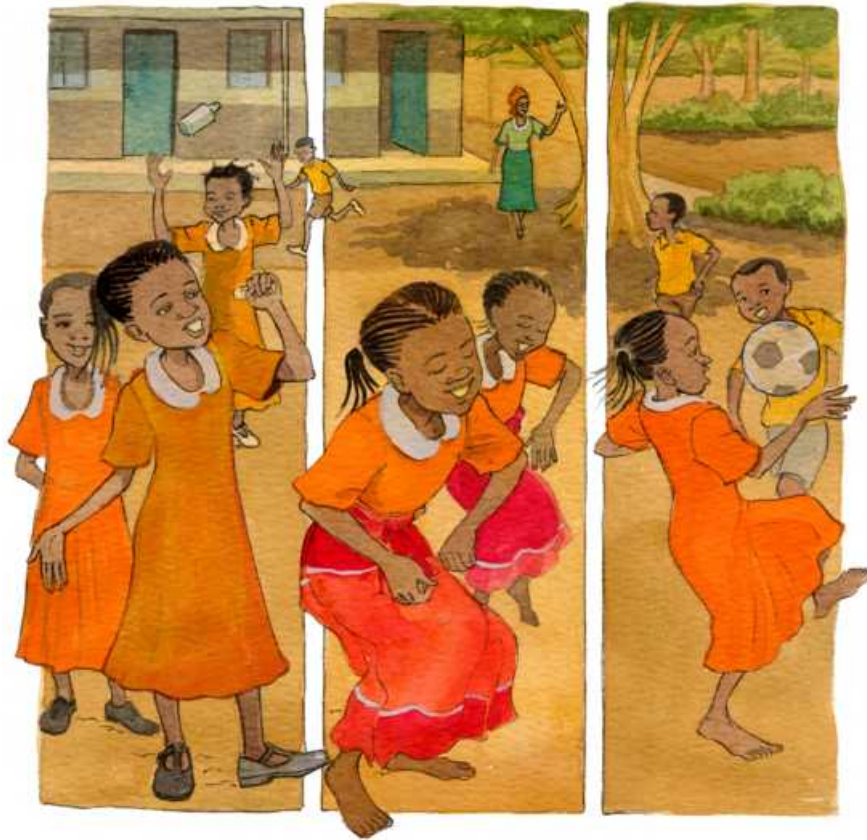
And I make sure little brother
