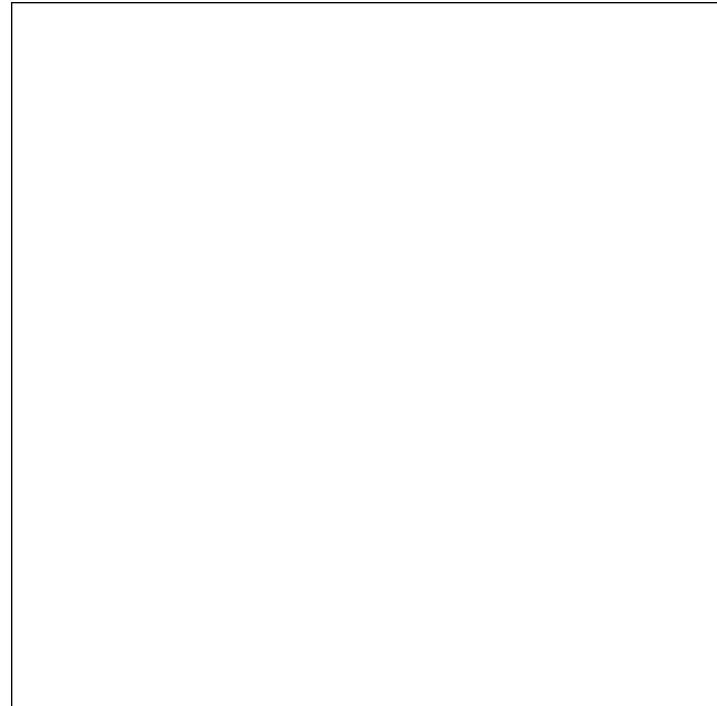



Ginagawa ko ang mga mabubuting bagay na ito araw-araw. Pero ang pinakagusto kong gawin ay maglaro nang maglaro!





And I make sure little brother knows all the school news.



