



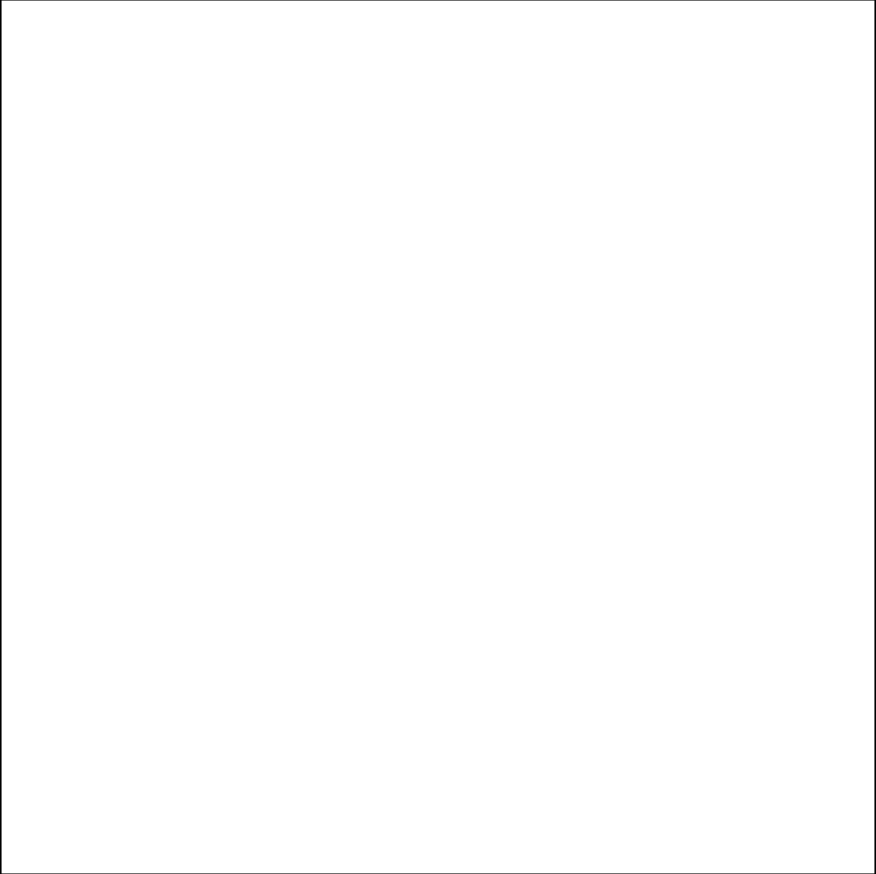
I cut the butternut.

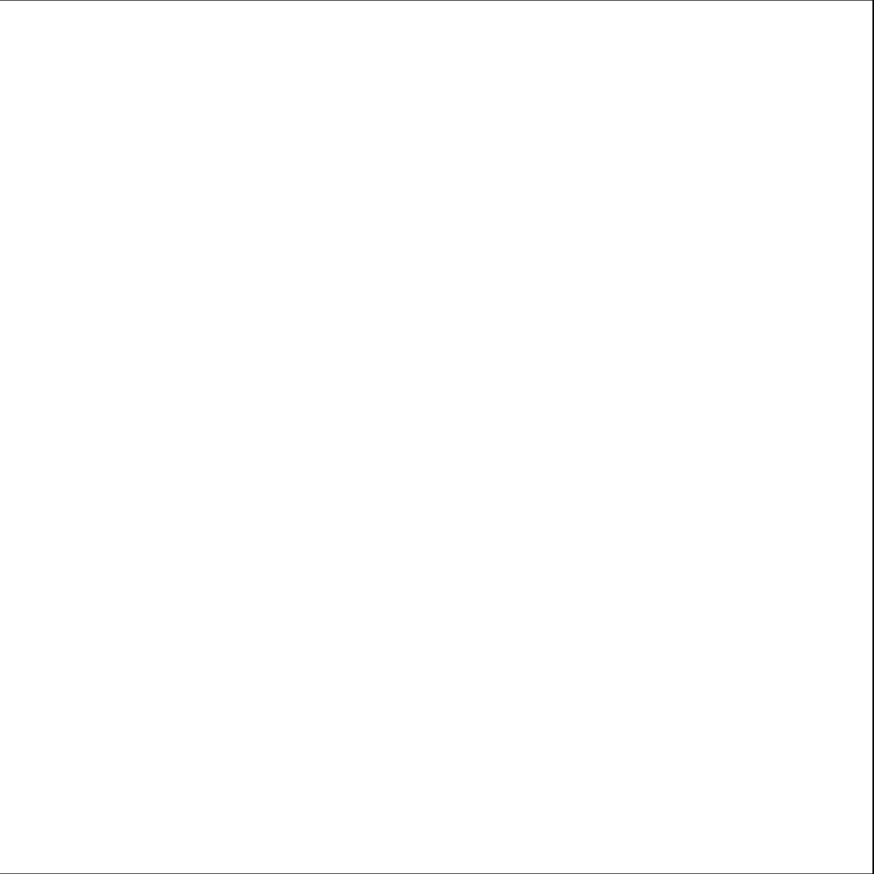
I chop the spinach.

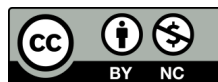
