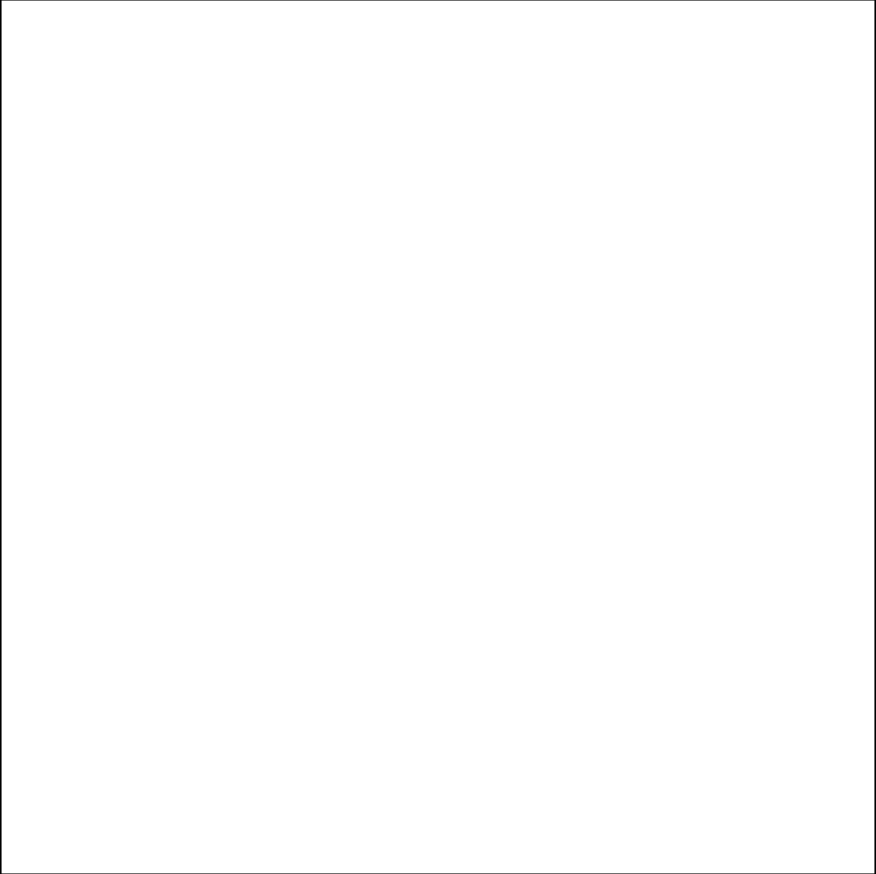
But they were not allowed to go

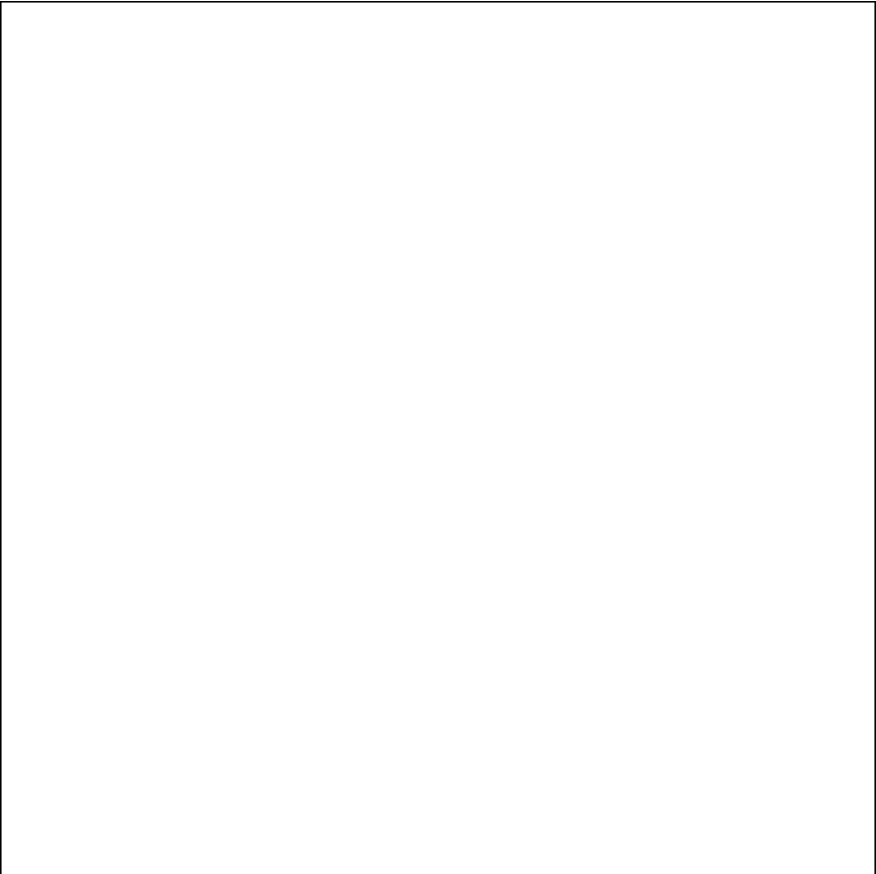
They had to do all their work

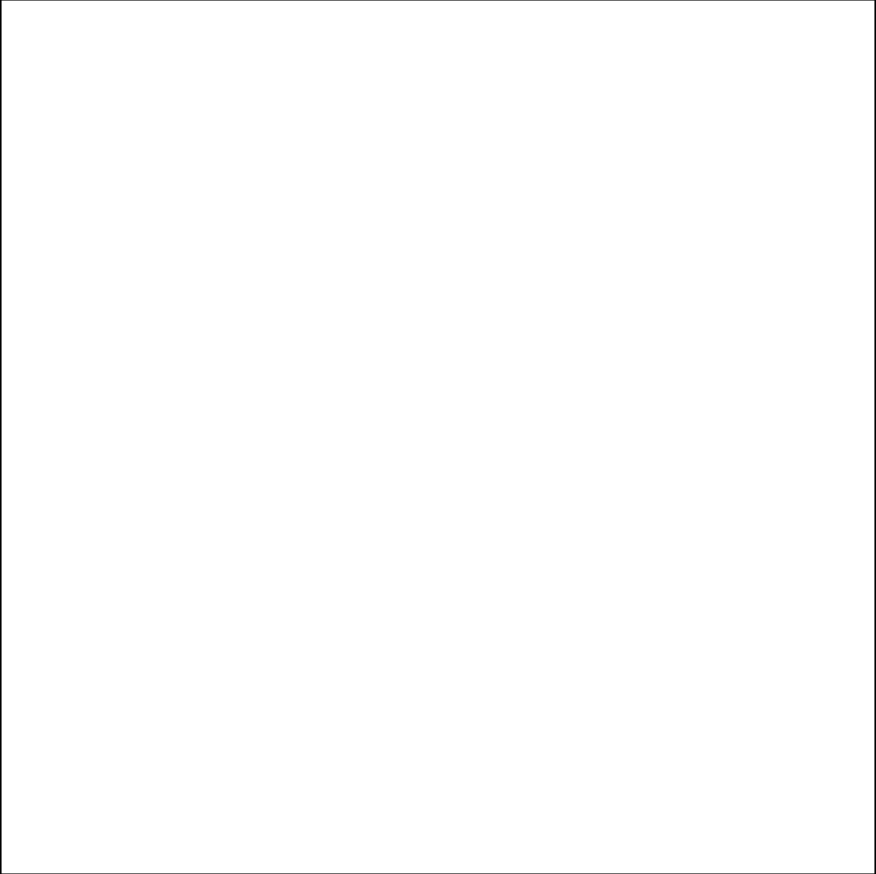
But one of the boys longed to go out in the sunlight.


One day the longing was too

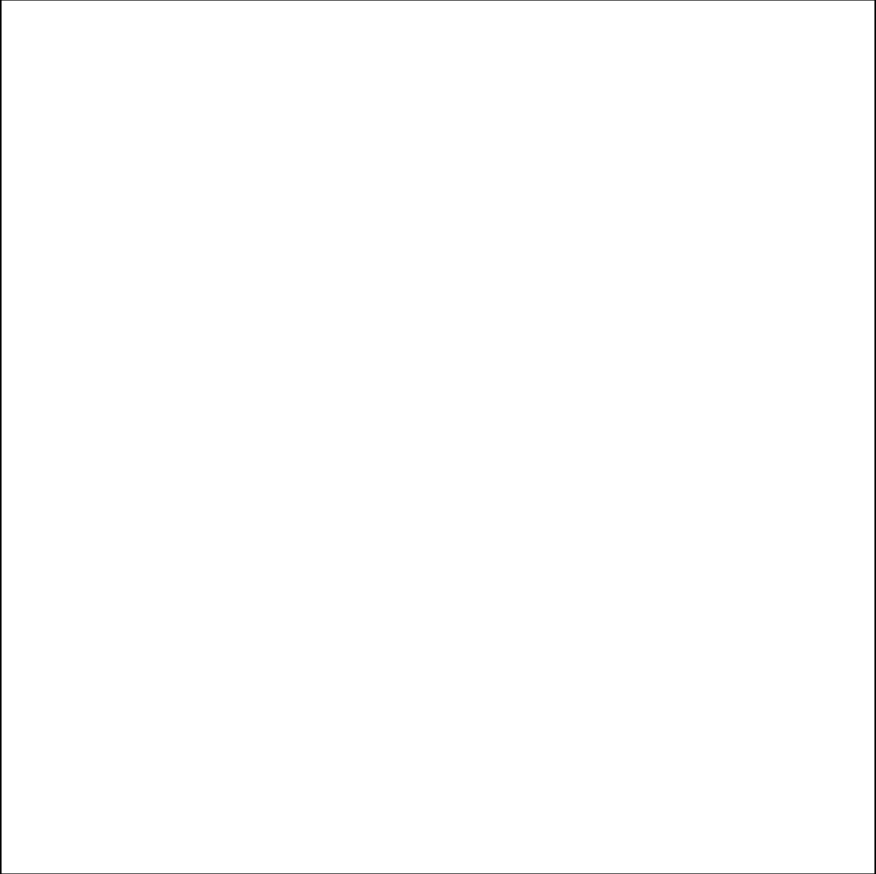
But it was too late! He melted in the hot sun.

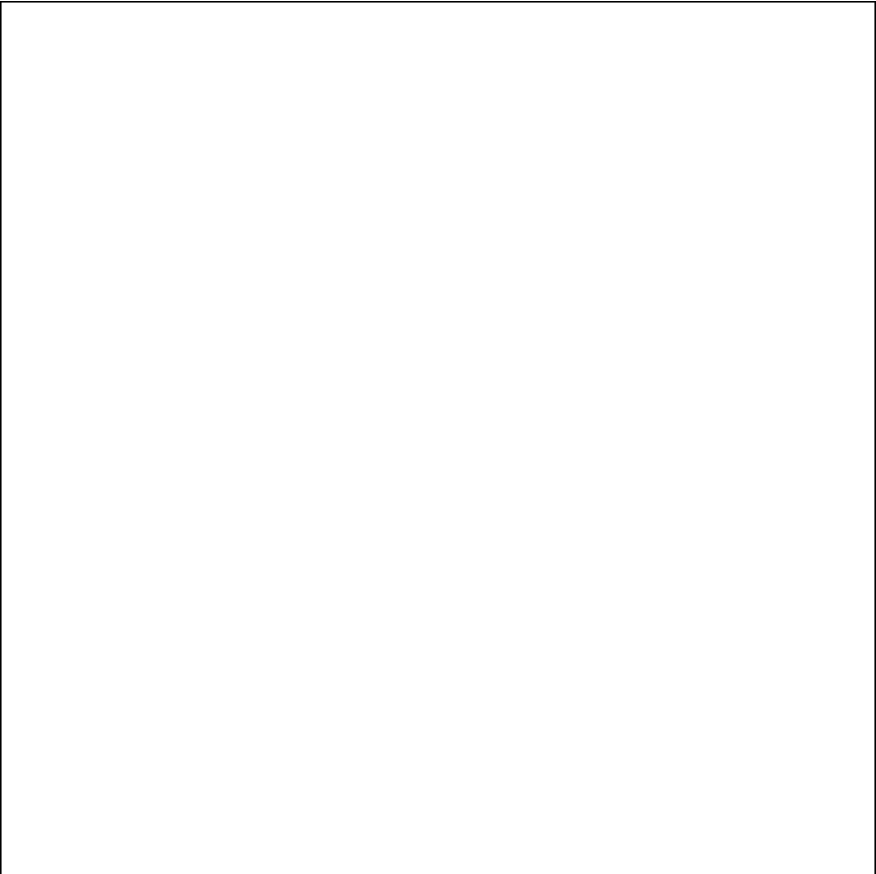
The wax children were so sad to see their brother melting away.

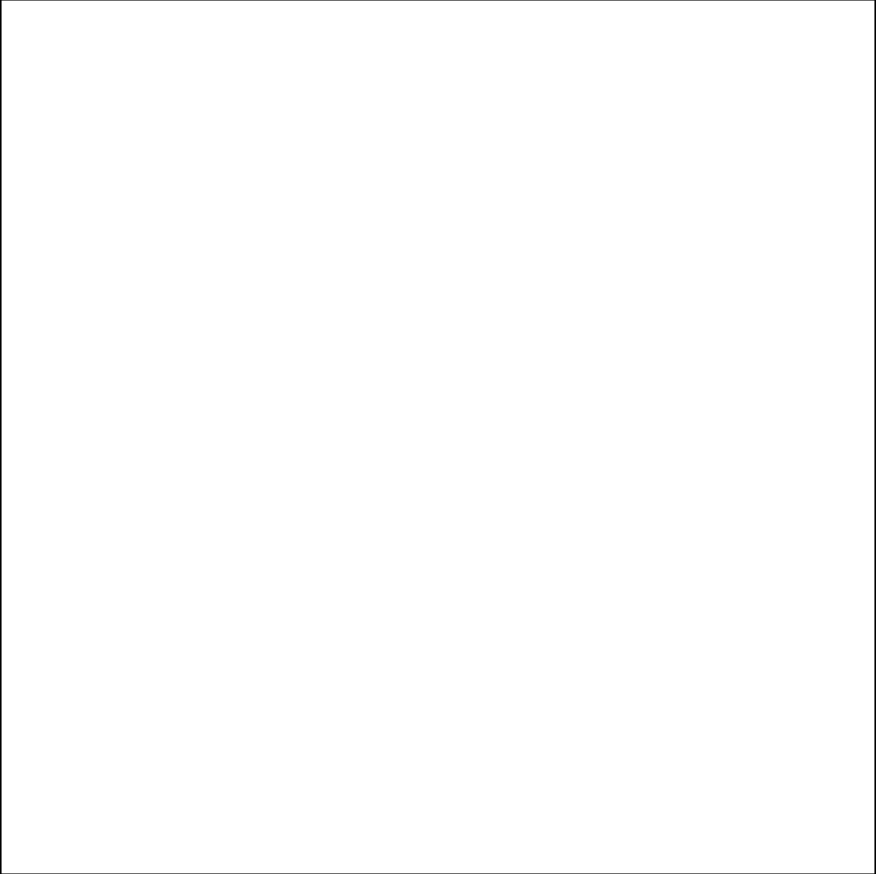
But they made a plan. They shaped
