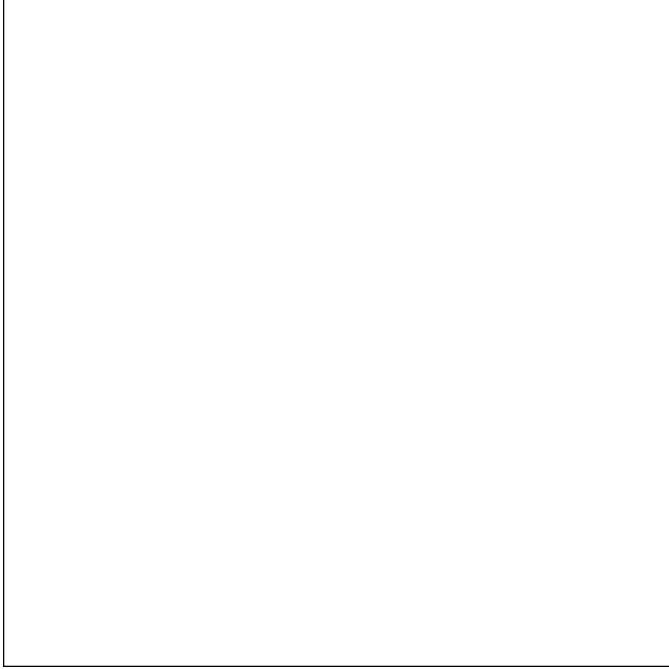





Mabubuting magkakaibigan sina

Nagbayad si Baka.





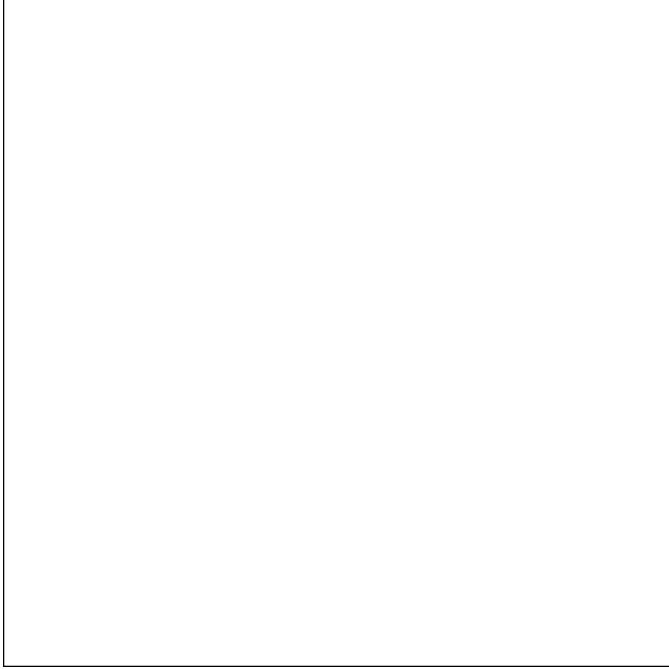
May sukli si Aso dahil hindi eksakto ang binayad niya.



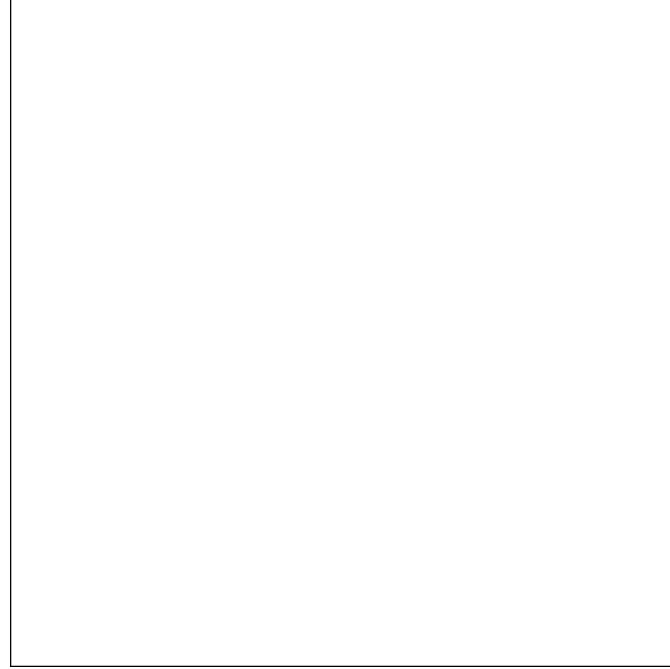
