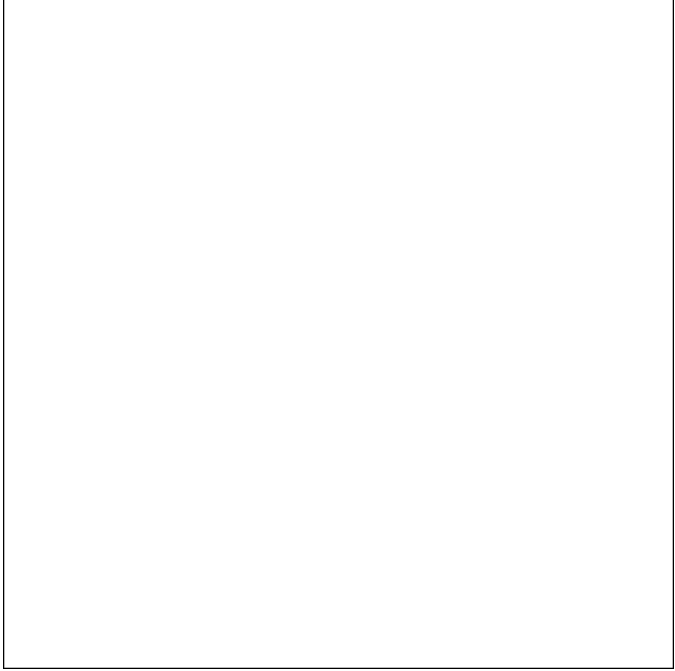


Namimili ng prutas ang mga tao sa iba.

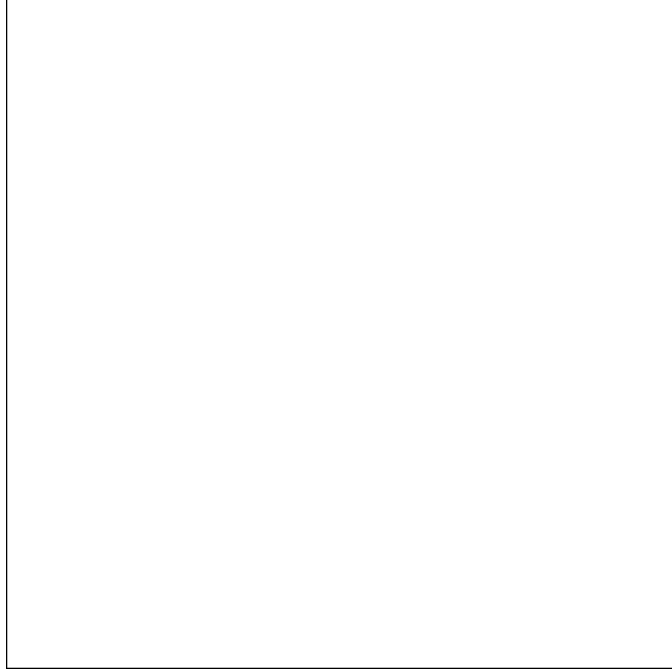


At pinasan niya ang lahat pauwi.

Pero walang bumibili kay Tom. Mas gusto nila ang mga babaeng tindera.

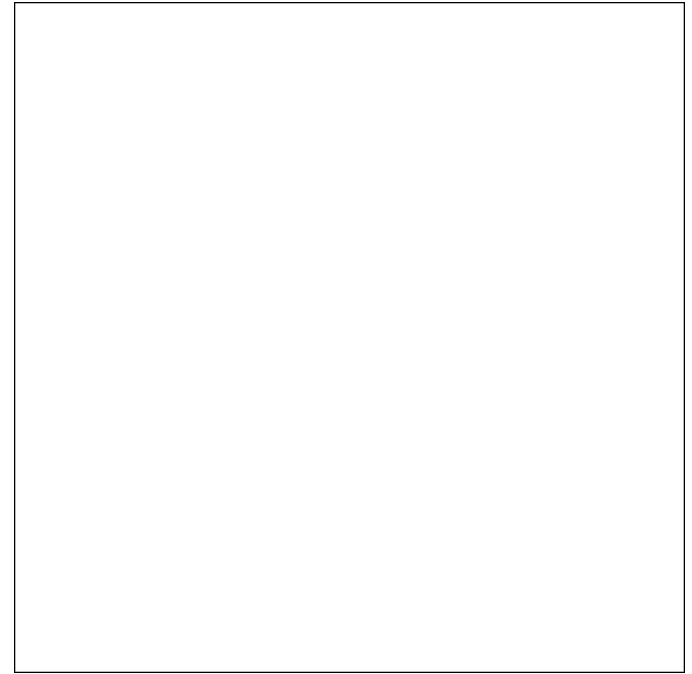


Saka siya bumili ng sabon, asukal at tinapay. Nilagay niya ang mga iyon sa trey.

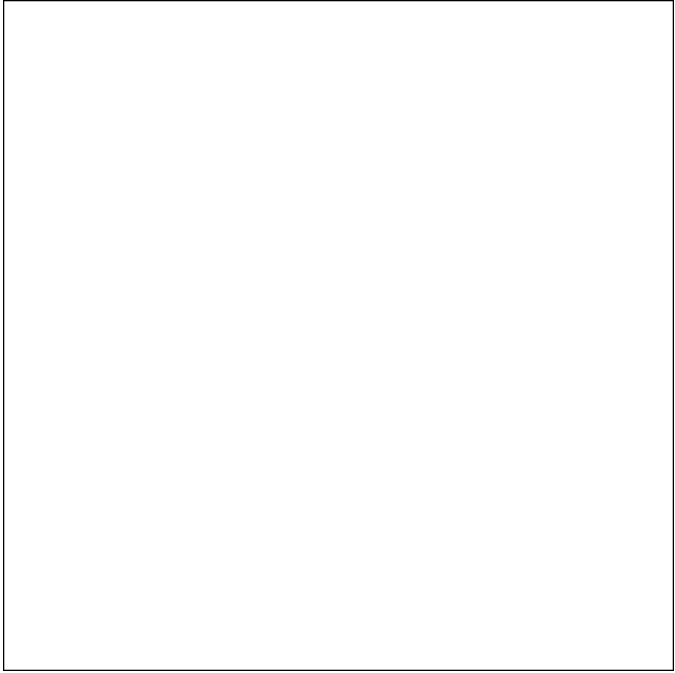




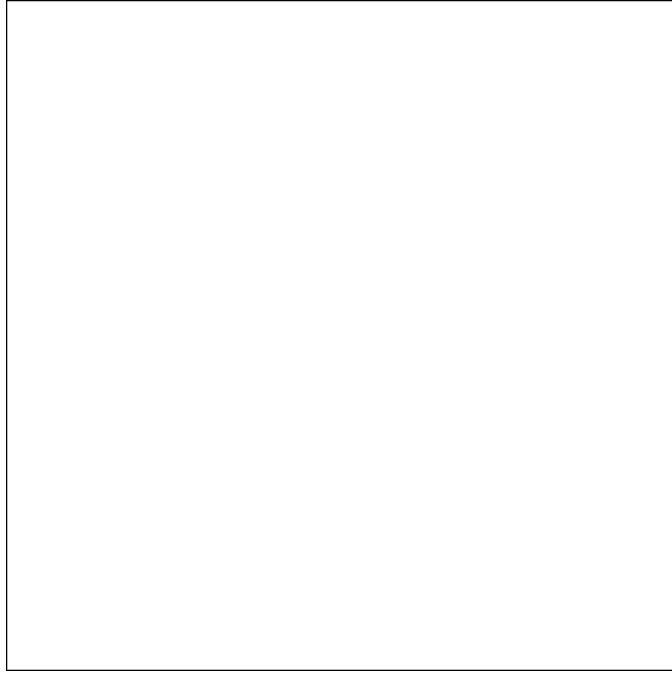

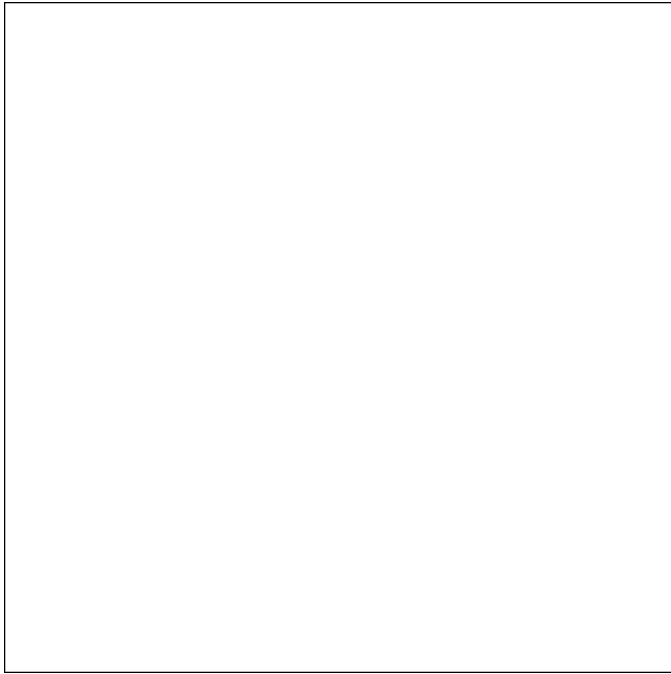
Mabilis na naubos ang saging. Agad binilang ni Tom ang kanyang kita.



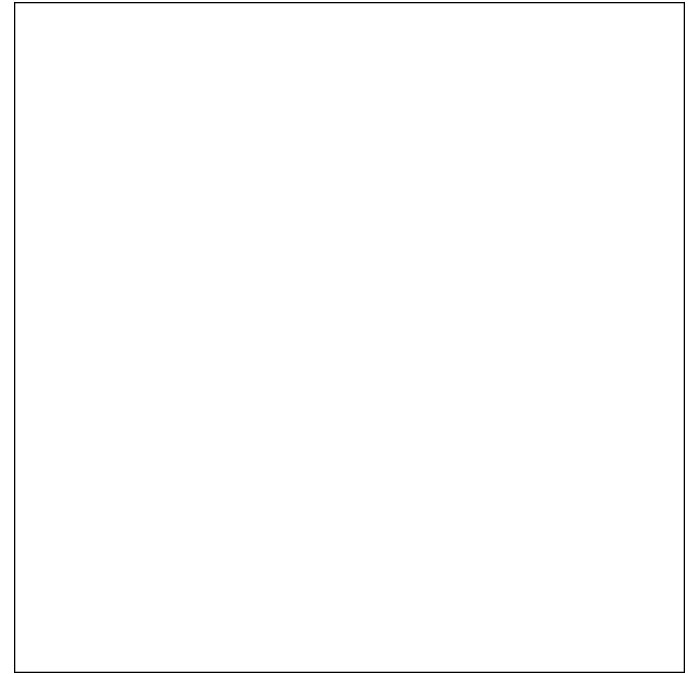
Pero hindi si Tom sumuko. "Bili na kayo ng saging! Matamis na saging kayo ryan!" sigaw niya.
