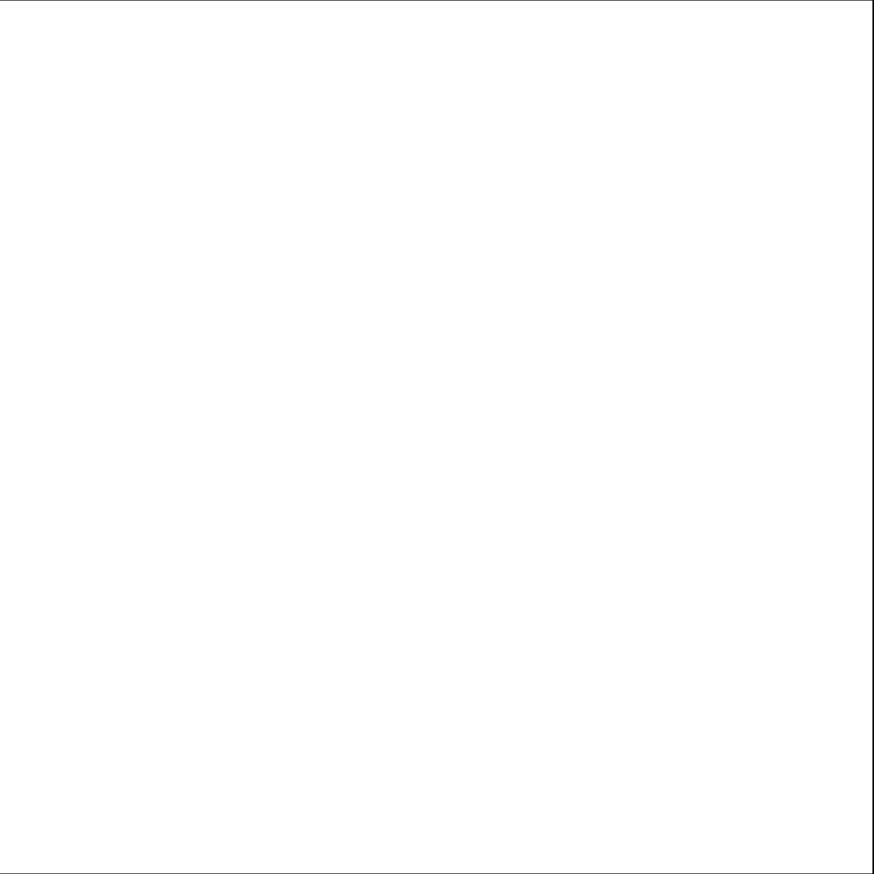
“Dito sa iskul, lalaki lang pwedeng maglaro,” sabi ng coach nang nakapamewang.

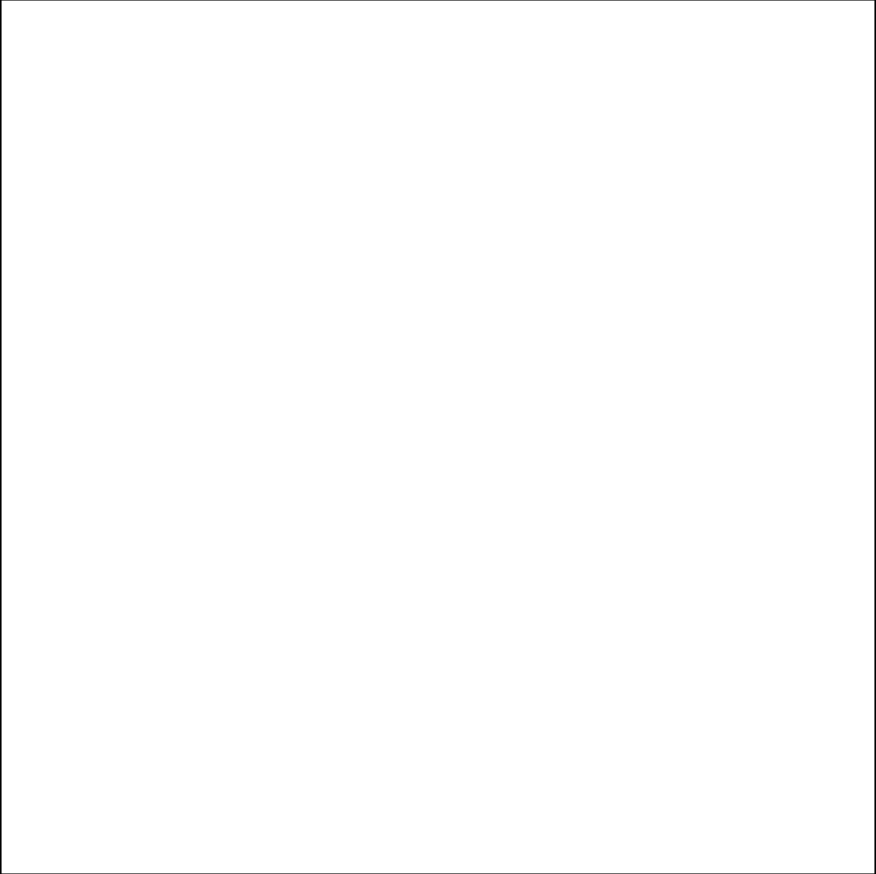
Sa sumunod na araw, may malaking laban sa iskul. Nag-alala ang coach kasi maysakit ang pinakamagaling niyang manlalaro.
